



Pool Rental Information, Rules and Rates

Rental Availability

The Ziegler Park pool is available for rental 7 days a week, during the hours of 8:30 PM to 11 PM only.

Reservation Process

- Pool rental request forms must be completed entirely, via our website: <https://zieglerpark.org/feature/pool/pool-rental/>
- After submitting your rental request form, a member of our team will contact you within 2 business days to confirm availability.
- Reservations are granted a minimum of 2 weeks in advance on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **A deposit of 50% of the rental price is required to complete a reservation.**

Event Timeline

8:00 PM	Pool closes to the public & Renter may begin setting up
8:15 PM	Party guests may begin checking in at admission desk (Renter will be provided with a pre-determined number of wristbands for guests)
11:00 PM	Rental ends, party guests depart, and clean-up begins
11:30 PM	Clean-up complete and pool gates are locked

Fee Includes:

- Facility rental fee and admission for all guests
- Required number of lifeguards and security personnel
- Ability to choose playlist or provide playlist on iPod or MP3 player for pool sound system
 - **Note:** Pool staff controls volume and all content must be family-friendly
- Use of pool furniture and 3 folding tables (tablecloths not included)

ZIEGLER PARK

Rules

- Renters and guests are required to follow all listed pool rules and regulations. See Page 4 of this document for a complete list.
- For a party with guests under 16, Renter must have 1 adult chaperone for every 4 children under the age of 16.
- Renter is responsible for assisting with clean-up after the party.

Guests can bring:

- Party decorations, including tablecloths.
- Food and party snacks.
- Non-alcoholic beverages ONLY (no glass containers). Ziegler Park holds a liquor license and **it is illegal to bring in outside alcohol**. If Renter would like to have alcohol served at the party, bar packages are available. See pricing on page 3. If Renter brings outside alcohol onto the premises, the rental will be cancelled immediately and open container tickets will be issued. Rental fee will not be refunded.
- If Renter would like the pool concession stand to remain open for the party, an additional charge of \$75 will apply, plus the cost of concessions products consumed. Renter has option to allow guests to purchase their own items or run a tab and pay at the end of the rental.

Cancellation Policy

- If the Renter should need to cancel the reservation, notification must be provided 48 hours in advance of rental time to Andrea Hawkins via email at ahawkins@3cdc.org. The Renter may reschedule on an available date within the same pool season. Should the Renter not provide notification of cancellation, the deposit will be forfeited.
- If the Renter cancels the reservation within 48 hours of the rental time, the deposit is forfeited and Renter does not have the option to reschedule.
- Should a closure of the Ziegler Park pool occur due to thunder and lightning, or equipment malfunction, Pool Management will inform the Renter and reschedule. If a date is not available, a full refund will be provided.



Add-on Bar Package

For an additional fee, Renters can add a Bar Package with the choice of Open Bar (Renter pays tab at end of the night) or Cash Bar (Guests pay per drink). Ziegler Park offerings include canned beer, wine, soft drinks and water.

ZIEGLER PARK

POOL RULES

- Any person under 16 years old must be accompanied by a person 18 years or older
 - Pool staff may request to see ID for proof of age
- One adult (18 and up) can accompany a maximum of four children under the age of 16
 - Adults who accompany children are accepting responsibility for each child and must remain inside the pool at all times. If they exit the facility, the children must also leave
 - Once an adult has entered the facility, he or she is unable to take responsibility for more children entering the pool, unless communicated upon entry
 - Non-swimmers must be at an arm's length from an adult at all times
 - Children in life jackets must be accompanied by an adult in every area of the pool
- Any person entering the facility must pay admission, even if the individual is not swimming
- No refunds will be given
- Swimming is prohibited when lifeguard is not on duty
- There is no diving at the facility, except at designated areas
- When jumping into the pool, swimmers must jump feet first and facing forward
- The pool staff are responsible for the strict enforcement of all rules and policies. Failure to comply could result in ejection from the facility.
- Children who require diapers, must wear swim diapers
- Vomit or fecal incidents require patrons to exit the pool
 - For stool/vomit incidents, guests will remain out of the pool for 30 minutes
 - For diarrhea, the pool will close for 13 hours for cleansing
- No smoking
- No Pets
- Snacks, small food items, and drinks are welcome
 - No food or drink allowed within 5 feet of the pool
- No running, boisterous or rough play
- No alcohol or amplified music without a permit
- No spitting or blowing nose in the pool
- No glass allowed in the pool or on the deck
- You should take a shower before entering the pool
- No intimate contact allowed in the pool
- Damage to property will not be permitted and violators will be held responsible
- During public pool hours, parties are not permitted on the pool deck including decorations or set ups of any kind. For information regarding throwing a party at the pool please visit zieglerpark.org
- Weather Policy
 - In the case of thunder/lightening, patrons will be removed from the pool for 30 minutes.
 - After each recurrence of thunder or lightening, the 30 minute period will restart
 - Once the weather clears, management staff will reopen the pool
 - No refunds will be given due to weather
